Current Criteria:

- Geographic location of school and surrounding student population

- Safety of students
- Size of school

Additional Criteria from Brainstorming Session:

- Balance in socio-economic status and ethnicity
- Considerations of new housing developments
- Minimize time student is on the bus
- More defined attendance areas
- Try not to divide neighborhood schools
